1. Current status of board to remain as is. We opted to forego any elections this year and proceed with the existing members for the foreseeable future, with Brad and Maureen as possible back-ups.
2. Scheduling was discussed. We just received the schedule from the city for August and they cut back on the number of tee times that we have to work with. Butch will reach out to Nathan to clear this up and present our desired tee times for 2027. We opted to reschedule the majors for 2027 along the same lines as we did in 2026.
3. The subject of searching for some tee times outside of the city courses was discussed. This can work with TMS with little notice, but there are a few issues to overcome. Wellman and Doug will coordinate an effort to get some possible alternatives. The biggest issues would be the price and the possible guarantees that each course would hold to. The club would need at least 4 tee times, SGC players would have to be held for no-shows, etc. Stay tuned.
4. George mentioned that there are Handicap adjustments available for anyone coming back for injury or illness. The Board decided that we will make this policy known to those eligible and let them decide if they feel it is needed.
5. New Member criteria. The Board decided that any new member will be accepted, dropping some of the previous requirements of playing a guest round and/or having a current club member vouch for them.
6. Discussion of a "cashless" option was discussed. No conclusion at this time.
7. Butch to reconsider the club's position on Golf Genius. It may be necessary to switch because of future changes with TMS.
8. The club's position on Preferred Lies was clarified. It was agreed that the policy will stay the same, with the player able to move the ball within a scorecard's length, no more.
